New Yorkers Born in the Dominican Republic

According to the US Census, there are 493,243 New Yorkers born in the Dominican Republic. 247,652 are individuals employed in the civilian workforce who are 16 years of age and older. Eighty-two percent are salaried workers employed in the private sector, while 11.4 percent work in the public sector, and 6 percent are self-employed. Most New Yorkers born in the Dominican Republic reside in the New York City Region (345,922 in the Bronx; 179,517 in New York County; 113,952 in Queens; 96,426 in Kings; and 14,721 in Rockland). Additionally, Long Island is home to 59,268 Dominican New Yorkers (31,073 in Suffolk, and 28,195 in Nassau). Westchester County is also home to 46,585 Dominican New Yorkers.
